July 6, 2020 Guild Meeting

The meeting was called to order by President Cindi Sullivan at 6:40 p.m. with a quorum present via Zoom.

- Cindi reminded everyone that 2020-2021 dues are now due and payable. Among the benefits of being a paid member are discounts offered by local quilt shops. She also reminded everyone to complete the membership form that was attached to the June Newsletter and forward it, along with their checks, to the USPS box. Forwarding the form with the check follows documented dual control procedures.
- The previous meeting minutes were accepted as written in the newsletter.
- Cindi announced the results of the 2020-2021 fiscal year officer election which is as follows:

- Cindi announced that Knit One Smock Two had donated 50 books, 2 quilt racks and some patterns. These items are in the Guild's storage unit.
- Cindi turned the meeting over to Vice President, Teri Craven, who introduced the program for the evening which was presented by Gloria Stickney, Guild member and owner of Sew Fabulous, Inc. in Winston Salem.
 - Gloria toured her shop and announced planned expansions, including curbside delivery, online shopping, as well as in-store shopping. She then demonstrated three different binding techniques.

- Quilts of Valor Chair, Tracy Burkart, reminded the group that there are 30 names on the list to receive quilts in October and commented that there are only 19 quilts in process. She requested additional volunteer efforts to ensure that these worthy individuals receive a quilt during the October presentation. She also noted that if the Guild does not meet in-person in October, she will conduct the presentations in her church.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:15.
