Are you ready? Your Committee Chairs have been busy planning and organizing our Quilt Show. Below are the details for our Show week.

Tuesday, April 5 is Show entries TURN IN. Swisher Center 1:00 to 7:00 in the same room as our monthly meetings. Remember to place each entry in a separate pillowcases. Micol, Candy and volunteers will guide you through the process. You will receive the form needed to pick up your entry after close of the Show. All entries will be placed in their pillowcases before any entry is released to its owner on Saturday AFTER close of the show. Please be patient. While you wait, please help with the takedown of our Show.

Wednesday, April 6 is JUDGING Day. This is a closed event for Gloria and volunteers only. Judging will take place at Swisher Center also. Scott Murkin from Asheboro is our judge.

Thursday, April 7 is LOAD-IN / SETUP DAY. Alan will rent a truck to pickup items from our storage unit and books and magazines from Linda F. house.

I will send out an email with times volunteers are needed to help load the truck.

Alan will drive the rental truck to NEIL BOLTON HOME and GARDEN building for SETUP of our SHOW.

The remainder of Thursday will be hanging quilts, unloading the truck and set up of our ENTIRE Show floor. Vendors will arrive in the afternoon. By the end of Thursday, magic and hard work happens and we will be ready to share our Quilt Show.

Friday, April 8 and Saturday, April 9 SHOW OPENS. Our hours are 9:00 to 5:00 each day. We ask that volunteers arrive at 8:30.

K 4 INSTRUCTIONS

Note: Use a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance and stitch right sides together for all construction unless otherwise instructed. It is important to keep same units and pieces together. We suggest using sandwich bags. Be sure to label each bag with the unit or piece reference name.

- Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of each I square. Place I right sides together with J; stitch $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side of the marked line, cut on the marked line and press I open to complete two I-J units referring to Figure 6. Repeat to make 68 I-J units.

- Sew H to D and H to E as shown in Figure 7; press seams toward D and E. Repeat to make 34 each D-H and E-H units.


