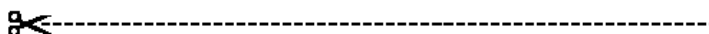

Amy opened the meeting at 5:32 pm.

The Board reviewed the previous year's budget and discussed changes for the 24-25 budget year.

The Board came to an agreement on the changes to the budget that will be voted on at the next member meeting on October 7th.

There was also discussion on the need for a Hospitality Chair position since no member has stepped up to chair this position. A discussion and vote will take place at the October meeting.

The Budget meeting ended at 6:10 pm

Social time then ensued prior to the presentation at 6:30 pm

Tracy Burkart started the presentation by introducing Cindy Grisdela who then began her presentation titled "Anatomy of an Improv Quilt." Members were given the option to attend the presentation in person or via ZOOM. Cindy has written two books and her website is www.cindygrisdela.com

At the conclusion of the presentation Tracy said currently only four people have signed up for Cindy Grisdela's workshop on Improv Puzzle on September 21, 2024 from 10:00am to 4:00pm via ZOOM. Tracy reminded us that a minimum of ten people must be signed-up for the workshop or it will be cancelled. Workshop cost is \$30. Space is limited to 24 Zoom attendees. The deadline to sign-up is August 12th.

Tracy called on Gina Kostelecky-Shankle who apologized for the delay in providing the final numbers for the quilt show. The delay was due to the fairgrounds waiting six weeks to submit their bill. So, with that bill amount now in the books, Gina said the guild made just under \$9,300 from the quilt show.

The meeting concluded at 7:35 pm.

There will be no meeting in September in observance of the Labor Day holiday.

The next meeting will be Monday October 7th at 6pm at the Swisher Center. The presentation will be "The Pizza Girls Trunk Show."

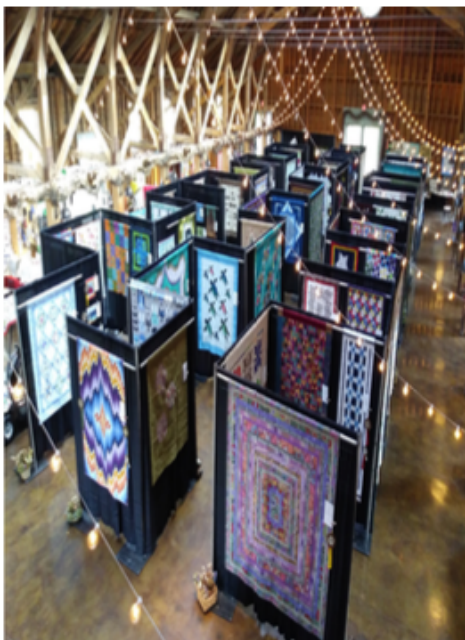
