2023 Monthly Mini Quilts

Monthly mini quilts is a monthly individual challenge. This is open to anyone who wants to participate. You can do as many or as few months as you wish.

Each month for 9 months, we will have a prompt or theme which you will use to create an original 8" x 10" quilt. The quilt should be based on what the prompt means to you, or maybe of something you remember or an emotion it evokes. These small quilts are meant to be a way to try out new techniques or ideas without having to invest a lot of materials or time on a larger quilt. The idea is to enjoy yourself. Original quilts are so much fun because there is no right or wrong, it is all up to the maker. Ideally, these small quilts should be three layers and closed along the edges, and contain at least some hand or machine stitching. Alternatively, you might want to make a block each month and put them together as a quilt later. Whatever you choose to do on the surface is up to you! Bring what you make each month to our meeting to show. It's about your interpretation of the theme.

The February mini quilt theme is: Love is....

Love is... does **not** mean to paper piece a heart with pink fabrics on a sweet background for Valentines Day. Express what Love Is.... means to you.

We will reveal the Love Is... quilts at our February meeting.
