Pattern Choices: Lee's [BLOOMING DRESDEN](#) quilt or her [GEORGIA'S DRESDEN](#) quilt.

The pattern is \$12 and may be purchased online, or in person at the August 7 meeting.

What to bring: Your own sewing machine, needles, thread, rotary cutter etc. If you would like to bring a small iron and ironing mat and a small tv tray, that can be accommodated. There will be TWO ironing stations for community use, and shop rotary cutters, that may be dull.

Meeting was then turned over to the Guild Vice President, Jessica Shouse, who introduced our speaker, Lisa Alley. The topic of the presentation was "What a Judge sees when judging a quilt."

Community Outreach Chair, Linda Fishell, passed out strip sets for outreach quilts and quilts that needed bindings. There were two finished outreach quilts presented.

Door prize Chair, Linda Nichols drew two tickets and awarded door prizes to two lucky members.

Website and Facebook Chair, Tracy Burkart, stated that the Challenge quilt poem was posted.

Quilts of Valor Chair, Marty Smith was also not in attendance. There was no update.

Raffle Quilt Chair, Linda Nichols reported there was no news regarding the current raffle quilt.

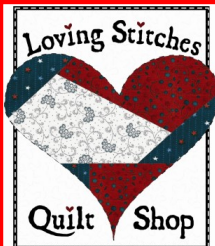
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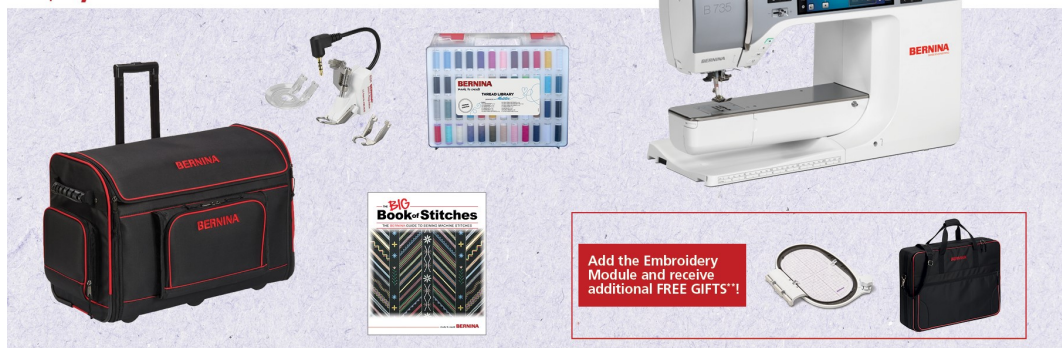
