Raffle Quilt Sew Days

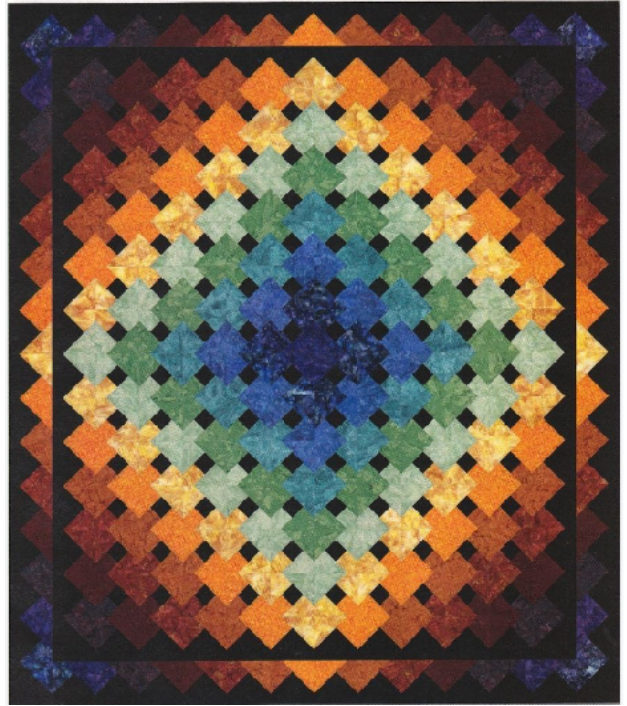
July 10th 9-6pm

For a tad bit of fun include something different,
A plant and/or a tree, just make them significant.

About those pesky borders, here's our rule for today-
Though not necessary, whatever you choose, why not add some appliqué.

When added all together for outside measurement to be ideal
You be sure they measure a total of 78-92", that's the deal.

My dear quilters in making this challenge, do follow your heart,
It shan't be difficult so I beg of you... get ready, go, go, and start!

June 5, 2023

Swisher Center

Alice Wise, President opened the meeting. She welcomed visitors. There were four visitors who stood up and introduced themselves. There were no new members.

Alice wished a happy birthday to those having a birthday in June. They were Wanda Wellborn, Darla Ballard, and Karen Leinbach.

Meeting was then turned over to the Guild Vice President, Jessica Shouse. Jessica introduced our speaker, Susan Brubaker Knapp. The topic of the presentation was "Yes, you can needleturn appliqué."

After the presentation, Alice Wise, President resumed with the business portion of the meeting.

Reviewed Secretary's May minutes. Motion was made to accept the minutes as presented. The motion was seconded. The May minutes were accepted as written.

Treasurer's report was given by the Treasurer, Lori Procter.

Beginning balance was \$22,917.64

Checks written totaled \$769.79

Deposits totaled \$ 1028.54

Ending balance for May was \$23,149.39

Membership Chair, Linda Nichols reported that 46 members were present.

She reminded membership that dues were due by August 1.

Newsletter Chair, Ellen Hart requested that information for newsletter be to her by the fifteenth of June. Ellen is also heading up the mini quilt activity. The theme for July is "Celebrate". She also said that the next theme would not be given until the August meeting.

Community Outreach Chair, Linda Fishell, read a thank you letter she received from Atrium Wake Forest that thanked the membership for the 28 quilts that had been donated.

Door prize chair, Linda Nichols drew three tickets and awarded door prizes to three lucky members.

Website and Facebook Chair, Tracy Burkart, was not present. There was no update.

Quilts of Valor Chair, Marty Smith was also not in attendance. There was no update.

Raffle Quilt Chair, Linda Nichols reported that the current raffle quilt would be at Pineapple Fabrics June 22-24 during their summer sale.

Minutes continued

Linda also gave the floor to Dawn Lathrop. Dawn is chairing the next raffle quilt. It will be a paper pieced quilt. Dawn announced that on July 9-10 there will be two sews days at the Swisher Center to assemble and finish the quilt top. All members are invited to help with this new challenge. Louis Schafer has agreed to longarm quilt the resulting quilt.

Quilt show co-chairs, Jessica Shouse and Ellen Hart gave an update.

Theme for the quilt show as voted on last months is "Follow Your Heart"

Dates for the show have been set for May 17-18 at home and garden center at Salem Fairgrounds Fran McKinney has written a poem listing the rules for the quilt show challenge a quilt. Fran read the poem at the meeting. Jessica and Ellen said it would be available on the website shortly.

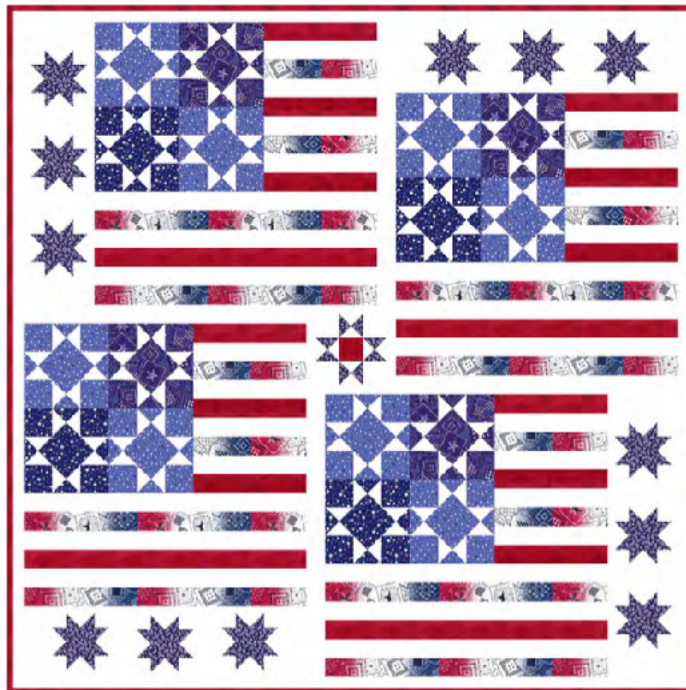
